Varanasi also known as Benares or Kashi is a North Indian city on the banks of the Ganges in Uttar Pradesh. Varanasi is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world. Varanasi grew as an important industrial centre, famous for its muslin and silk fabrics, perfumes, ivory works, and sculpture. Buddha is believed to have founded Buddhism here around 528 BC when he gave his first sermon.

It is the site of Banaras Hindu University (BHU), which is one of the largest residential universities in Asia with over 20,000 students. Varanasi is well-connected by air, rail and road. Varanasi is served by Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport, which is approximately 26 km (16 mi) from the city centre in Babatpur. Air India, Air Vistara, Buddha Air, Jet Airways, Jet Konnect, IndiGo, and Spice Jet operate flights from Varanasi to Delhi, Gaya, Kathmandu, Khajuraho, Sharjah, Lucknow, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Bangalore, and Kolkata. Varanasi has main two Railway stations, Varanasi Railway Cantt station and Mughal Sarai. The mean temperature in February ranges from 26 degree high to 11 degree low. Varanasi has all hotel chains viz Taj, Raddison, Ramada, Clarks, Hindustan International and many more 3-5 stars hotels.
